We closed that teaching with everyone reciting Ps 119 33-40 which is a powerful prayer for every saint of God who takes there spiritual growth seriously.

On Sunday we started at **Lu 20:24**

**Lu 20:24** Shew me a penny. Whose image and superscription hath it? They answered and said, Caesar's.

**25** And he said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's.

\*My 1st question to the class is

**What is the likelihood of being caught off guard and deceived when you know truth?**

**Acts 8: 5** Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them.

**6** And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.

**7** For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed *with them*: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

**8** And there was great joy in that city.

**9** But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:

**10** To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is the great power of God.

**11** And to him they had regard, because that of long time he had bewitched them with sorceries.

**12** But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.

*We should not allow ourselves to be led astray by the craftiness of men.*

**1Thes 5:4** But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.

**5** Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.

**6** Therefore let us not sleep, as *do* others; but let us watch and be sober.
